The CBC NL Pensioners Association Scholarship continues to remember the dedication and valuable input of all association members who have passed away, leaving us with wonderful memories.

The CBC NL Pensioners Association established this scholarship to encourage and assist students with post-secondary education studies in any discipline by providing an annual grant of \$500.

The CBC NL Pensioners Association Memorial Scholarship is sponsored and administered by the Newfoundland and Labrador Region of the CBC Pensioners National Association.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship an applicant must be:

1. A child, grandchild, great-grandchild, niece, nephew, grandniece or grandnephew of a CBC NL

Pensioners Association member/spouse who worked with CBC in Newfoundland and Labrador.

2. Enrolled as a full-time student in an educational program at a recognized university, college,

academy, technical/trades school, or other post-secondary institution for advanced learning.

3. Registered for the **second year or higher level** of a post-secondary program.

4. Not in receipt of a previous award from the CBC NL Pensioner Association's scholarship program.

Responsibility for an application rests with the applicant. Each section of the application form should be completed. <u>Scholarship applications must</u> <u>be postmarked or emailed by May 31, 2025.</u> The scholarship will be announced in mid-June.

The CBC NL Pensioners Association Memorial Scholarship selection committee reserves the right to authenticate all information pertaining to this application. The decision of the Committee is final.
